Anolyte to cleanse bird flu

Recently, a group of researchers in the Ministry of Science, Technology and Environment (MoSTE) conducted tests of a disinfectant solution called anolyte that is hoped will help the fight against bird flu.

If anolyte is allowed to be used, a large amount of money on disinfecting farms could be saved. Following is the interview on its effects on H5N1 prevention with Doctor Nguyen Hoai Chau vice head of the (MoSTE)

You have written a good assessment on the application of anolyte in the bird flu fight. What are its attributes?

The first thing that I want to confirm is that the substance is harmless to people and the environment. Domestic as well as foreign scientists have attested the fact.

In addition, anolyte is a strong and fast disinfectant. Tests done by the Central Veterinary Department of Vietnam shows that anolyte can kill H5N1 just after one minute of contact.

Could anolyte be used throughout the country?

Anolyte has been used at over 200 establishments throughout the country. We have worked with Thuy Phuong centre for poultry research, the National Centre for Veterinary Hygiene and Central Veterinary Department of Vietnam to popularise the concept of using anolyte as an effective disinfectant.
